



# Curriculum Overviews

## Mathematics

Students start to learn numbers to 10. They make connections between number names, numerals and quantities. In Space, they are introduced to terms that describe positions of different objects such as, underneath, next to and on top of. Students also start to learn about asking questions and collection information from their peers to answer these questions.




## English

Students become familiar with their new environment and begin to participate in shared reading of literary texts. They learn about the key features of picture books. They learn to read and write simple three letter words through a systematic, synthetic phonics approach.


## HASS
