



# Curriculum Overviews

## Mathematics

Students start to learn numbers to 10. They make connections between number names, numerals and quantities. In Measurement, students sequence and connect familiar events to the time of the day.

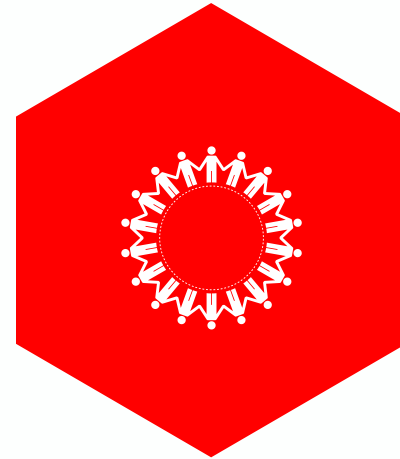


## English

Students read a range of information texts about what they are learning in Science. They identify key features of informative texts such as text structures and language features. Students begin to learn and practice writing simple sentences. They continue to learn and extend their knowledge of letter-sound relationships by starting to write sentences about living things.

## HASS

Students investigate families and what they look like. They compare what life was like for them and other generations.



## Japanese

Students are introduced to aspects of Japanese language and culture. They learn simple greetings and begin noticing similarities and differences between Japanese and English.



## Health & Physical Education

Students extend their learning from Term 1 about emotions. They identify and describe the different emotions people experience. In Physical Education, students learn a range of catching and throwing techniques that further build their fundamental movement skills..



## The Arts

Students continue to learn the skills of Music as they practice for their upcoming eisteddfod performance. They are fine tuning their performance skills as they explore melodies, timing and presentation.
