

Curriculum Overviews

Mathematics

In Term 3, Prep students continue to build strong foundations in number sense and early problem solving. They will learn to say number numbers from 0 to at least 20 while also recognising and writing these numerals. Students will match number names with quantities and use the language of more or less; bigger or smaller. In addition to this, Prep students will learn to recognise and name familiar 2D shapes like circles, squares, triangles and rectangles. They use hands-on materials to create these shapes and sort them into groups based on their features.




English

In phonics, our Prep students will continue to build on the foundational phonics knowledge learnt in Semester 1. They will continue practicing segmenting and blending to build stronger word level fluency while also transferring these skills reading longer sentences and short decodable texts. Students will also develop confidence in expressing themselves and communicate with others. They are learning to share short recounts of familiar events by talking about things that have happened and putting these events in order.



In Semester 2, students begin to explore the world around them by learning about familiar places - like their home, school, local park, library and shops. They begin to understanding how places are different, what makes them special and how we can take care of them.








Science

In Science, students learning about different objects and toys and learn to describe how they move. They will learn language such as roll, bounce, slide and spin to discuss why certain toys move a certain way.



In Health this term, Prep students are learning how to keep themselves safe in everyday situations. They explore safe behaviours around medicines, fire and water and learn who can help them if they're ever unsure or in danger. In Prep, Physical Education extends beyond just running and playing. They are learning how to work with others, take turns, follow rules, and talk about how they feel when they're active and having fun.







The Arts

Students continue to learn the skills of Music as they practice for their upcoming eisteddfod performance. They are fine tuning their performance skills as they explore melodies, timing and presentation.
