Year 1

Term 1, 2026

Mathematics

Students continue to learn and consolidate numbers to 120 and connect their number names, numerals and quantities together.

They learn the foundation of place value by showing how you can break one- and two-digit numbers in different ways.

Students solve problems involving addition and subtraction of numbers to 20.




English

Students read a range of literary texts including picture books. They learn about nouns, verbs and adjectives and how these are used in picture books to make a character come to life.



HASS

Students investigate families and what they look like. They compare what life was like for them and other generations.



Science

Students learning about changes in our seasons and daily weather. They begin to think like scientists to collect weather observations using tables and share their weather predictions with each other.



Health & Physical Education

Students recognise and celebrate strengths and achievements of both themselves and others. They explore how these contribute to their identity. In physical education they further develop their fundamental gross motor skills by engaging with a range of catching and throwing techniques..



The Arts

This term students continue to enhance their Music and Dance knowledges. In Music, students use their body to create a percussion piece to accompany a familiar song. In Dance, students are exploring the theme of movement in the sky. Through fun and imaginative movement students are developing their ability to move safely in space, explore body actions and express ideas through dance.



Technology

In Design Technologies, students investigate the design process to plan, construct, test and reflect a marble run. They communicate their design ideas using models and drawings.
