

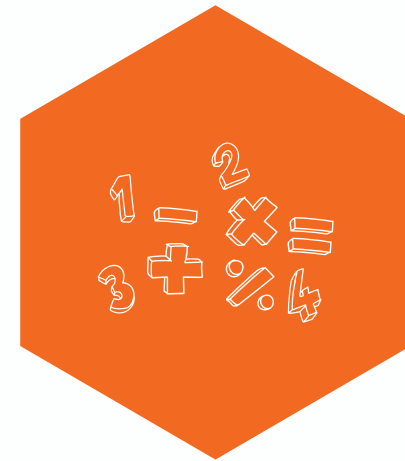
Curriculum Overviews

Year 1

Term 2, 2026

Mathematics

Students continue to learn and consolidate numbers to 120 and connect their number names, numerals and quantities together. They learn the foundation of place value by showing how you can break one- and two-digit numbers in different ways. Students solve problems involving addition and subtraction of numbers to 20.



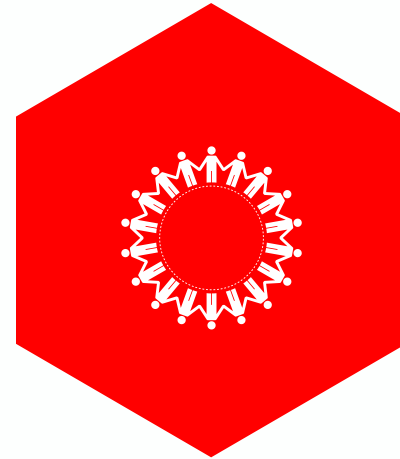
English

Students read a range of informative texts and learn about the key features of these texts, with a particular focus on procedures. They create a short informative procedure using simple sentences and apply what they are learning in phonics.



HASS

Students investigate families and what they look like. They compare what life was like for them and other generations.



Science

Students explore what different plants and animals need to survive. Students look at how air, water, food or shelter help plants and animals survival.



Health & Physical Education

Students recognise and celebrate strengths and achievements of both themselves and others. They explore how these contribute to their identity. In physical education they further develop their fundamental gross motor skills by completing a range of scooter board challenges.



The Arts

This term students continue to enhance their Music and Dance knowledges. In Music, explore where music is experienced in different places around the community, country and world. They continue to explore elements of dance to choreograph and perform a new dance.



Technology

In Design Technologies students use the design process to create marble runs that select design ideas. They use models and drawings to communicate their ideas.
