

Curriculum Overviews

Mathematics

In Term 3, students are building on their skills with numbers and using simple strategies to solve everyday problems. They are learning to connect numbers, words, and quantities, and to use hands-on methods to understand adding, subtracting, sharing and grouping. In Measurement and Space, students are learning to measure things by using consistent units like paper clips, blocks, and or hand spans, helping them understand size and length. They explore different shapes and objets, sorting them by features like the number of sides, corners, or their size and comparing which are bigger or smaller.




English

In phonics, Year 1 students are becoming more fluent readers at both a word and whole text level. They are extending their knowledge by learning more complex digraphs. Also, they are learning how to share their thoughts and ideas confidently and explain why they think or feel a certain way. These skills help them become great communicators, thoughtful listeners, and respectful classmates.



This semester, students begin to explore their local neighbourhood in more detail. They are encouraged to ask questions, investigate, and learn about the different kinds of features that make up the places around them. They recognise different types of features in their local area, including: natural features, managed features and constructed features.





Science

In Science this term, students are learning to observe and describe how the world changes from day to day and across the seasons. They explore how these changes affect how we live, what we do, and what we wear.



In Year 1 Health this term, students are learning more about themselves and their feelings, how to care for their wellbeing and safety, and how to ask for help when they need it. In Physical Education, students build their physical skills through games and activities that develop coordination, balance and teamwork. They are developing their skills in kicking, passing and catching using techniques from Australian Rules Football. They're beginning to solve simple movement challenges by thinking, trying and testing different ways hitting a target.







The Arts

This semester for The Arts, Year 1 students will explore both Music and Drama. In Music, students explore how music connects to the world around them - especially the places and experiences in their own community. They learn to listen carefully, talk about what they hear, and express their ideas through rhythm and sound.
