


# Curriculum Overviews

#### **Mathematics**

In Term 3, students are developing a deeper understanding of numbers, multiplication and division and fractions. They're using this maths to solve real-world problems and learning to explain their thinking clearly. In Measurement and Space, students use familiar metric units such as centimetres, metres, litres and kilograms to estimate, measure and compare length, mass and capacity of everyday objects.




# **English**

In Term 3, students are developing confidence in sharing their opinions and preferences, speaking clearly and thoughtfully. They are learning how to organise their ideas, use topic-specific vocabulary, and use their voice effectively to engage their audience. Students are using rich authentic texts to continue to build their word and text level fluency.

## **HASS**

Students are developing skills to explore and understand different places by collecting and using geographical information. They learn how places can be very different from one another and why those differences matter.







### Science

Students are investigating how heat affects different materials. They explore what happens when heat is added or taken away from solids and liquids, helping them understanding everyday changes like melting, freezing and evaporation.

# **Health & Physical Education**

In Term 3 in Health, students are developing important skills to make informed decisions about their health and wellbeing by understanding health messages in advertisements. In Physical Education, they are also learning fundamental physical skills through basketball, building coordination, teamwork and confidence.







#### **The Arts**

In Music, students look at the traditions and practices from different countries and cultures. They practice singing, playing instruments and improvising music from around the world.
