Mathematics

Students are building strong skills in working with decimals and fractions, using place value to understand numbers in new ways, solving real-life financial problems. They also estimate, measure and describe shapes and objects accurately.

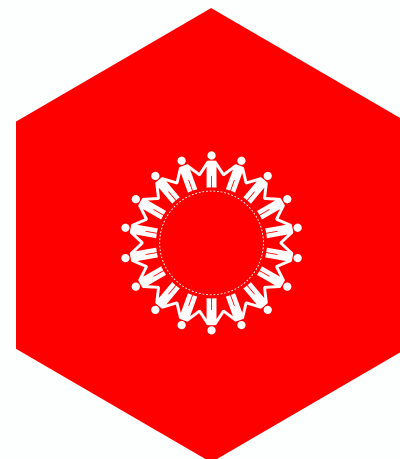


English

This term students are developing skills to confidently share their ideas, opinions and information through spoken arguments. They learn how to structure their talk clearly and use language and voice to persuade and engage their listeners.

HASS

In Term 3, students are exploring how people interact with different environments across Australia and the world. They are learning about natural features of places, how people use these environments, and how we can make better choices to use them more sustainably - for the benefit of both people and the planet.



Science

Students are investigating the properties of everyday materials and how those properties influence the way objects are designed, made, and used. They explore why some materials are better suited to certain tasks and how we can choose materials wisely for different purposes.

Health & Physical Education

In Term 3 in Health, students are developing important skills to make informed decisions about their health and wellbeing by understanding health messages in advertisements. In Physical Education, they are also learning fundamental physical skills through basketball, building coordination, teamwork and confidence..



The Arts

In Music, students learn how to compose a song about a superhero by selecting and organising sounds, silence, tempo and volume. In Dance, students explore how dance can be used to express ideas, stories, and different perspectives. They learn to use movement with purpose and creativity while building physical coordination and confidence in performing.
