

Curriculum Overviews

Mathematics

Students are developing a deeper understanding of numbers, multiplication and division and fractions. They're using this maths to solve real-world problems and learning to explain their thinking clearly. In Measurement and Space, students use familiar metric units such as centimetres, metres, litres and kilograms to estimate, measure and compare length, mass and capacity of everyday objects.

English

Students are developing confidence in sharing their opinions and preferences, speaking clearly and thoughtfully. They are learning how to organise their ideas, use topic-specific vocabulary, and use their voice effectively to engage their audience. Students are using rich authentic texts to continue to build their word and text level fluency.

HASS

Students explore the diversity of people, places, communities, and environments - both within Australia and across the globe. They learn how to describe, compare, and explain the unique characteristics of different locations, and they use a variety of tools to organise and present geographical information clearly.



Science

Students will investigate how materials can change when heated or cooled. They will observe, test and describe changes through hands-on experiments and use science vocabulary to explain their findings.

Health & Physical Education

Students will describe the connections they have to their community and identify local resources to support their health, wellbeing, safety and physical activity. They will interpret health messages and discuss the influences on healthy choices.

In Physical Education, students will refine the fundamental movement skills of throwing (overarm shoulder pass and chest pass) and catching, and apply concepts and strategies to solve challenges in games. They will apply strategies for working cooperatively and apply rules fairly.



The Arts

In Music, students look at the traditions and practices from different countries and cultures. They practice singing, playing instruments and improvising music from around the world.



Digital Technologies

In Digital Technologies, students plan a sequence of steps (algorithms) to create a solution, including visual programs.
