

Curriculum Overviews

Mathematics

Students will build their understanding of number, fractions, decimals and problem-solving. They will use a range of strategies to solve every day mathematical problems and explain their thinking. Students will also explore measurement, shapes, location and data through practical learning activities. They will continue to develop confidence when choosing strategies, working mathematically and sharing their ideas.

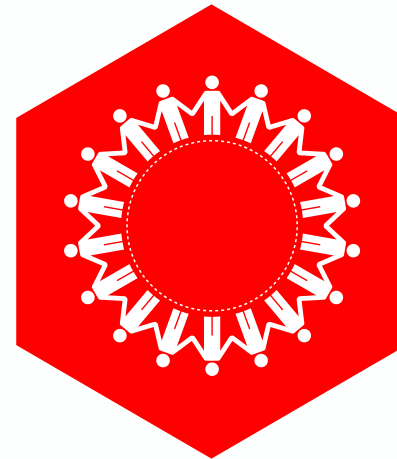
English

Students will explore a range of texts and build their skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening. They will develop ideas, use vocabulary and language features to suit their purpose and share their thinking clearly with others.

HASS

Students will explore how people, places and environments have changed over time. They will investigate the connections between communities, the importance of rules and decision-making and how people can care for places.

Students will develop their inquiry skills by asking questions, locating information, using sources and sharing their ideas.



Science

Students will explore scientific ideas through questioning, investigating and observing. They will make predictions, conduct simple investigations, record their findings and explain their thinking using science vocabulary.

Health & Physical Education

Students will describe the connections they have to their community and identify local resources to support their health, wellbeing, safety and physical activity. They will interpret health messages and discuss the influences on healthy choices. In Physical Education, students will refine the fundamental movement skills of throwing (overarm shoulder pass and chest pass) and catching, and apply concepts and strategies to solve challenges in games. They will apply strategies for working cooperatively and apply rules fairly.



Digital Technologies

In Digital Technologies, students plan a sequence of steps (algorithms) to create a solution, including visual programs.



The Arts

In Music, students learn how to compose a song about a superhero by selecting and organising sounds, silence, tempo and volume. In Dance, students explore how dance can be used to express ideas, stories, and different perspectives. They learn to use movement with purpose and creativity while building physical coordination and confidence in performing.
