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
## Our initiatives include

- ✓ Continue to implement our whole school *Response to Intervention Framework* to provide Tier 2 intervention and support for students. This intentional and targeted additional support will be provided 3 times a week for *all*, to assist students to demonstrate achievement against the year level achievement standards and proficiency scales in Reading. Each cohort's data will be monitored and individual students tracked to develop Individual Support and Curriculum Plans as required.
- Continue to provide Tier 3 support with stakeholders within the school (SLP, GO, HOSES, Chaplain, BAT, Learning Support) to flagged students, due to students not showing progress with Tier 1 and 2 intervention. This includes the purchase of additional SLP days to deliver additional intervention and support beyond Regional allocation.
- ✓ Continue to use the *High Reliability Framework* (Marzano) to inform school improvement.
- ✓ Continue to build teacher capacity through our timetabled Professional Learning Team meetings to drive student improvement through our Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum and Proficiency Scales for English,

## **Investing for Success**



✓ Continue to implement our pedagogical framework, *The Art and Science of Teaching*, through focused coaching and feedback opportunities with the support of our Master Teacher to ensure a consistent language of practice is evident across all classrooms. Leadership Team to commence a rollout of walk throughs and formal observations to ensure line of sight in classrooms and provide feedback to build teacher capacity and teaching teams.

Continue to employ Lead Teachers (2.0) to drive student intervention as part of the whole school Response to Intervention model and provide support in high yield pedagogical practices for teachers.	\$157 527.66
Continue to employ a Speech Pathologist (1 x 0.2 FTE) to assess identified students in Prep – Year Two. Develop and facilitated oral language programs for teachers and train teacher aides to implement and monitor Support-A-Talker progress. This includes further implementation of our phonological awareness and 'Olly' oral language program for identified students.	\$20 853.46
Employ Additional Teacher Aide support hours to delivery our Response to Intervention Framework.	\$120 925.88
